| DAY 1 |

PRAYING IN UNITY

"Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven."

| MATTHEW 18:19 |

Incredible power is released when we agree together in prayer. The world we live in is a spiritual one. Every time you pray, you aren't just saying words into the air—you are taking action in the spirit! When linked together in unity, your prayers are joining a battle in the heavenly realms, sparking change that God wants to see take place on the earth. Let's all pray now together for the coronavirus! Pray for healing and a cure. We pray this evil virus would bring a Great Harvest.

My wife, Sue, and I daily practice the prayer of agreement, and God has brought us astonishing results. One of the most gratifying of our answered prayers involves our unbelieving family members. Sue and I put together a list of 28 of our relatives in the back of our Bible. It took us 35 years, but we have seen everyone on our list get saved!

Praying together in agreement every day is one of the most powerful things we do together in ministry. You can agree in prayer with your friends, coworkers, small group members, or you can move into exponential agreement together as a local church. Get ready to see souls coming to Christ and lives changed by the power of Holy Spirit!

| DAY 2 |

INTERCEDING FOR SALVATION OF FAMILY MEMBERS

"Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them."

- HEBREWS 7:25 -

You may have been praying for your family members for a long time and they still have not responded to the Good News. Take heart! Each person you are interceding for in your family presents another opportunity to embrace God's heart for them. Jesus wants you to learn the value of persevering in prayer, for He is already at work interceding for you and your family, with steadfast patience and endurance.

My uncle Mark's salvation is a classic illustration of the power of persevering prayer. My uncle was a successful millionaire from a Buddhist background, but he was also an alcoholic and chain smoker. He was always closed off to the Gospel. Our whole family interceded for him for 20 years before he started opening up to the Truth. After reaching rock bottom relationally and financially, my uncle ended up giving his heart to Jesus at an evangelistic crusade, where he had a powerful encounter with the Holy Spirit. Strongholds were broken off his life, his marriage restored, and since that day, Uncle Mark has been serving Jesus wholeheartedly!

There is nobody so far gone that God cannot save him or her. Not one of your family members is beyond God's reach! It's His desire to welcome everyone in your family into His Kingdom. Continue to pray for them, and in God's timing, I believe you will see the fruit of your faithful intercession.

Lord Jesus, give me Your heart to intercede for my family members and help me to persevere in prayer for each one of them.

| DAY 3 |

THE POWER OF FASTING

"Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke?"

- ISAIAH 58:6 -

Early on in our marriage, Sue and I moved into a new level of intercession for our unsaved relatives when we added fasting to our prayers. We made the decision to set aside every Tuesday to fast and pray for our family members. So we skipped breakfast and lunch, devoting those times to intercession, and then broke our fast at dinner time.

We developed this discipline during our early years on the leadership team of a large Bible study in the 70's, and we were so encouraged as thousands of people came to know Jesus during those years. We also learned about the power of prayer and fasting through the Jesus People Movement and its sweeping revival. Then through my partnership with Lou Engle in the fasting and prayer movement known as The Call, I continued to witness firsthand the importance of fasting and the incredible results that it can bring. And believe me: If I can fast as a bona fide foodie, you can, too!

Fasting is so important because it will take your focus from the realm of the visible into the realm of the spirit. We deny ourselves, and God moves. We do not fast to force Him to move, but fasting often accompanies a sobriety to see change. The Word of God encourages us to pray with fasting, declaring that when we do, He will pour out His Spirit on all flesh. That's when things really do change. So never stop praying!

Lord, show me how You want me to fast and pray for my family, that You would bring freedom to my relatives by the power of Your Holy Spirit!

| DAY 4 |

CONSECRATION AS A SINGLE

"I am saying this for your own good, not to restrict you, but that you may live in a right way in undivided devotion to the Lord."

- 1 CORINTHIANS 7:35 -

If you are a single, you are at a time in life when God can shape your future in radical ways. Before you have started the adventure of raising a family or buying a home, you have the incredible opportunity and flexibility to seek God's will for your life and be obedient to His voice. He may be calling you into a career in a new city, or maybe even full-time mission work in another country. This is the time to dream with God!

Our heavenly Father makes each of us unique, so our families will reflect our unique callings and giftings. If you desire to be married someday, bring your requests to God as you continue to pursue Jesus above anything else. Trust that His timing is perfect, and He will lead you into the right relationship that is worth your full commitment.

| DAY 5 |

PRAYING WITH YOUR SPOUSE

"Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves.

A cord of three strands is not quickly broken."

- ECCLESIASTES 4:12 -

Whenever you come together with your husband or wife, Jesus promises to be there and meet with you. As we see in the prayer of agreement, the effectiveness and power of your prayers are multiplied when you pray together with your spouse. When you both dedicate this time to the Lord, you are giving Him the space to knit you together spiritually, emotionally, and relationally. A healthy marriage is built on the bedrock of prayer.

Every morning my wife and I pray for a fresh infilling of Holy Spirit. As we do this, we are posturing ourselves right from the beginning. One of our top priorities is to pray together for our children, grandchildren, and the specific needs of our family. Even when I am on the road, we make an effort to call each other every day, and we pray for our church and our staff members by name. Because this is a strong value in our lives, by the grace of God, we are able to consistently receive the strength, direction, and refreshing that the Lord provides during this time.

When you and your spouse are intentional about praying together, you will start to see miracles increase in your lives. Soon enough you'll find yourself beginning the day with, "Lord, thank You for answering that prayer. Thank You so much for what you are doing in our lives." I encourage you to begin your prayer time by entering His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise. The Spirit of the Lord is with you, and He wants to empower you and release His Kingdom through you!

DAY 6

HONORING YOUR PARENTS

"Honor your father and your mother, as the Lord your God has commanded you, so that you may live long and that it may go well with you in the land the Lord your God is giving you."

- DEUTERONOMY 5:16 -

The most fundamental dynamic in any family is the relationship between you and your parents. God has a heart for your entire family, but first of all He is calling you to show honor to your parents. In fact, this is the first commandment God ever gave with a promised attached! Living a life of fullness, prospering, and abundance is directly linked to your response to honor your father and mother.

I was blessed with two incredible parents. Both have gone home to be with the Lord, and both have left behind a legacy of being a great man and woman of God. Although my upbringing was rocky in many ways, once I met the Lord, I realized the enormous value of extending honor to my parents. We are all meant to constantly be thanking God for our parents, asking Him to bless them and make them fruitful laborers in His Kingdom.

Not every parent has a relationship with Jesus, and not all have modeled a spirit of honor for their children. You cannot honor everything your parents ask of you if it directly conflicts with the Word of God. But when it leads to blessing, God says that if you honor your parents, then as a part of His order, things will go well with you. The blessings and favor of God will be released into your life whenever you honor those He has placed in authority over you.

Heavenly Father, I choose to honor my parents today. Bless my dad and my mom with the richness of Your Kingdom, and draw them closer to You with each new day.

DAY 7

GIVING A PARENT'S BLESSING

"The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit."

- PROVERBS 18:21 -

Abba God began His relationship with us by giving a Father's blessing. After creating Adam and Eve, He established both their identity and their destiny with His blessing. God created you to live a life that is fruitful and abundant. He also created you to walk in His authority on the earth. One of the ways Abba God wants to manifest His love and power in your life is through the blessing that comes from a parent.

My whole life and ministry changed in 1996 when I received a blessing from my dad. Leading up to that time, God showed me that I had been harboring bitterness in my heart toward my dad ever since I was a child. So, the day finally came when I opened up and asked for his forgiveness for the wrongful attitudes that I had toward him. My dad's response stunned me as he humbly asked me to forgive him for the ways that he had hurt me growing up. Then he told me for the first time in my life, "Son, you know how proud I am of you. And I love you very much." So many emotions flooded my heart as I was healed by my father's words of blessing!

God the Father wants to bless you, and He wants you to extend a father's or mother's blessing to your children, too. Your words of affection and affirmation provide powerful support for your kids. Speak identity into them—who they are in Christ and how much they mean to you as a parent. Make Spirit-led declarations over their destinies, that they would walk in the fullness of God's overflowing blessings for them!

I declare a blessing of love and divine favor over my children. I bless my kids to walk in their identity and fulfill their destinies, in Jesus' name!

| DAY 8 |

PRAYING FOR YOUR CHILDREN

"This, then, is how you should pray: 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.'"

- MATTHEW 6:9-10 -

My wife and I love to pray for our kids. Every morning we lift up each of our children in prayer, targeting the specific challenges and opportunities they and their families are faced with. Sue and I start with the Lord's Prayer, and we stop at each point to pray for our children by name. We pray for God's Kingdom to come and His will to be done in their hearts and their lives—for His rule and reign to manifest in our children's lives on earth as it is in heaven. By being intentional in seeking His face and praying for our family, we have seen God do so many miracles. He delights to answer our prayers!

During their early years, we prayed that each of our kids would come to know Jesus at a young age. | DAY 9 |

PRAYING WITH YOUR CHILDREN

"Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it."
- PROVERBS 22:6 -

Children are so impressionable. The simple act of sitting down with your kids and ac-knowledging the Lord's presence with them will set them on the path of life and abundance. When children see you model prayer and spiritual authority at home, they will follow your example and learn how to practice God's presence on a daily basis.

As young parents, Sue and I instilled in our children the value of going to God in prayer.

Prayer is an every day, every moment activity. It is our constant connection with God through the hills and valleys of life. As our children grew up, they received continual reminders that God listens to every word of prayer they lift up to Him.

Listening intently to the Father's heart as His child is an essential part of our walk of faith. Jesus wants your little ones to know that they can call on Him at any time. They can talk with Him as a Father and Friend. And like the psalmist, they will be able to boldly say, "I called on the Lord, and He answered me!"

| DAY 10 |

PRAYING FOR A PRODIGAL CHILD

"But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him."

- LUKE 15:20 -

I believe that love is proportional to hurt. The more you love a person, the more that person has the capacity to hurt you. If your son or daughter has broken relationship with you, or with God, there is understandably a lot of emotional pain involved. But just imagine how much more God the Father's heart is moved by this situation.

An incredible testimony comes to mind involving one of my friends from New York City. Years ago, his daughter left the church, had a baby outside of marriage, and was living with her boyfriend. This caused much grief to her father, who went through a season of depression. One evening, the father and his entire church congregation united in fervent prayer for the wayward daughter. The very next morning, the daughter appeared at her parents' home—weeping and earnestly asking for forgiveness! Both she and her boyfriend then gave their lives to Jesus, got married, and ended up working on staff at the father's church.

Every time a wayward son or daughter comes home in repentance, it brings indescribable joy to the Father's heart. Jesus helped us picture this joy in His story of the Prodigal Son: At first sight of his returning son, the father runs out to greet him and immediately shows lavish displays of love. Whatever your circumstances may be, keep your son or daughter in prayer, and entrust them to the Lord. God's heart is for your child to come back into His fold, where there will be great rejoicing awaiting them!

Father God, I entrust my child into Your hands. Bring them home and encounter them with Your love and the power of Your Holy Spirit.

| DAY 11 |

SEEKING RECONCILIATION

"All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation."

- 2 CORINTHIANS 5:18 -

Families are all about relationship. When emotional and relational bonds are weakened or broken, the entire family often experiences the stress resulting from a severed relationship. Perhaps you can think of someone in your family who has hurt or offended you in the past. No matter where the fault lies, the love of Christ compels us to seek restored and renewed relationships, especially among our relatives.

One of the most impactful experiences in my life was when God brought reconciliation to my relationship with my dad. I grew up under the leadership of a God-fearing father, but there were many moments when his method of punishment crossed the line into physical abuse, which left deep wounds in my heart. On a certain occasion, I felt led to bring this up in conversation with my dad in a spirit of humility. To my astonishment, and to the glory of God, this resulted in both my dad and my mom asking me for forgiveness—the first time I had ever heard those words from them!

It is the Father's good pleasure to heal relationships between family members. He is calling you to be an ambassador of healing and reconciliation in your family. Invite Holy Spirit to move on your hearts and follow His leading as you pursue restored relationships with your relatives.

Jesus, show me how You want to move in my family to bring restoration and healing to our relationships.

| DAY 12 |

PRAYING FOR BROKEN FAMILIES

"The Lord builds up Jerusalem...

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds."

- PSALM 147:2-3 -

Everyone wants their marriage to be strong and healthy, but unfortunately we don't see that as the norm in society today. When I was growing up, divorce was a rare phenomenon. Yet today five out of nine marriages end in divorce, and many families are broken and dysfunctional. Your family may very well know what it is like to face trying circumstances like these.

The world would have you believe that your family is forever destined for dysfunction and disillusion—but God! All my life I have seen the Spirit of God move on hearts to heal and restore hope to families of all shapes and sizes. The relationship between a husband and wife, and between children and parents, carries such value in God's Kingdom. In the midst of relational turmoil and brokenness, God wants to move on your behalf.

Take the initiative in your family to set the new norm, where humility, compassion, and forgiveness are to be expected. Replace patterns of division with acts of service and words of encouragement. Don't believe the lie that divorce is inevitable. It doesn't matter what you've been through or how hard things may seem. I believe the power of Holy Spirit can, and will, make all the difference in your family!

Holy Spirit, come and build up my family. Heal our hearts and restore our relationships through Your love and power.

| DAY 13 |

SEEKING FORGIVENESS

"Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you."

- COLOSSIANS 3:13 -

Love starts in the home. I have found that a good way of gaging our heart is to ask ourselves, "How well am I loving those closest to me?" People usually find it easy to love others who love them back, but it takes a supernatural grace to love people when they have hurt you. And that means forgiving others with the same forgiveness that Christ shows us.

For the most part of our 40-plus years of marriage, Sue and I have had an amazing journey, but in 1992 we hit a wall. We had a big fight, which led both of us down a road of depression, and we went to professional counseling for some time. It took a dramatic encounter with God in Toronto for me to realize how harsh and unkind I had been to Sue during our marriage. I first demonstrated my change of heart through my actions and then deeply repented before her one evening, asking for her forgiveness. Heaven came down that night, and a deep healing took place in our marriage!

Every marriage and every family will still have those moments that I call "intense fellowship," but things will be radically different when we walk in forgiveness as a way of life. Since Sue and I have cultivated a lifestyle of forgiveness, we have enjoyed the best years of our marriage, by the grace of God! The Father wants to bless your relationships in your family, and it all begins with being conduits of His love and freely forgiving each other in the same way that He has forgiven us.

Lord, show me how I can be an ambassador of forgiveness in my family.

| DAY 14 |

PRAYER FOR SINGLE PARENTS

"Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need."

- HEBREWS 4:16 -

We are currently living in the most fatherless generation. Statistically speaking, 40% of births taking place today are to a single parent. Many times (though not exclusively) it is the mother who then takes on the full responsibilities of bringing up a child. Single parenthood can be very taxing physically, financially, and emotionally. But it is God's desire to work mightily in your situation!

Consider the story of Dr. Ben Carson. Growing up in inner city Detroit with his mother, Ben struggled in school and dealt with anger issues due to his father's absence. Yet his mother relentlessly encouraged him, held him accountable academically, and spoke destiny over his life. Ben would eventually graduate with top honors from high school, attend Yale and then medical school. In 1987 he gained international acclaim by being the first neurosurgeon to successfully separate 8-month-old twins joined at the head.

Nothing is impossible with God! If you are a single parent, I want you to know without a doubt that God's grace will be more than enough for your situation. Go to your Abba God confidently, to be refreshed, strengthened, and renewed. He will bring great blessing, success, and stability to your home if you simply open your arms to receive it by faith.

Abba God, I come to You confident of Your love for my family. I receive Your grace and strength for today, and I declare a blessing over my children's lives in Jesus' mighty name.

| DAY 15 |

PRAYER FOR THE FAMILY OF GOD

"I ask that out of the riches of His glory He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being."

- EPHESIANS 3:16 -

If you are a born-again believer, you are part of a big family! Deeper than any other relational ties, our identities are defined by our relationship with God and being part of His family. Sometimes the call to follow Christ means being rejected by your blood relatives because of your faith. Other times, there may not be many family members who live close or maintain contact with you.

| DAY 17 |

| DAY 18 |

When Jesus teaches that we are to bear much fruit, I think He is covering everything from the fruit of the Spirit to being productive in life. However, the Bible is very specific that God also wants to bless the fruit of your womb. As in the Garden of Eden, God blesses us for a purpose: to be fruitful, multiply, subdue the enemy, and rule and reign with Him over the earth. In short, God wants a massive family to love!

Make your family's top priority be to love each other with the love of Christ, and you will be amazed at what God does.

| DAY 29 |

LEARNING YOUR LOVE LANGUAGES

"A new command I give you: Love one another."
As I have loved you, so you must love one another."

- JOHN 13:34 -

Despite what many in the world may think, love is not all about an emotional experience. The ability to sustain a loving relationship with your spouse and with your family members begins with you making a choice: to love them sacrificially, with God's agape love. You may have heard it said, "Love looks like something." One helpful pattern of translating love into action is to learn your family's love languages.

My wife's love language is quality time. Spending time together is incredibly important, and for us this can look like a weekly date, family night, or regular devotions together. Sue also knows that my love language is acts of service, so she often expresses love and honor in practical ways that mean a lot to me. When I'm coming home from a long trip, Sue goes out of her way to get my clothes dry-cleaned and she'll even prepare a delicious home-cooked steak dinner for me. I am so blessed!

Family matters aren't always easy, but with the proper truths from Scripture and with God's help, you have the power to cultivate a great marriage and a healthy family. Get to know each other's love languages. Look for fun, creative ways to express God's love to your family members.

| DAY 30 |

FAMILY MOUNTAIN OF CULTURE
