1 LOVE IN ACTION

scripture: *John 4:5-9*

Love is the most powerful tool in advancing God's kingdom. In this story, Jesus interacted with a Samaritan woman and asked her for water to drink. In Jewish culture, men were not allowed to associate with Samaritans and even more so, women. The Samaritan woman did not believe she was worthy of this interaction. 2 LOVE IN POWER

scripture: *John 4:16-18*
